

TECHNICAL COOPERATION COUNCIL OF THE PHILIPPINES

FY 2020 ACCOMPLISHMENT REPORT

Pursuant to its mandate of providing non-degree, short-term technical training for the Developing and Least Developed Countries, TCCP considered the implementation of the following projects for 2020:

- Training of Trainers on PalayCheck System cum Rice and Rice-Based Technologies for Sri Lanka
- Dispatch of Philippine Coconut Authority Expert to Sri Lanka
- Training on Gender Mainstreaming for Sri Lanka
- Training on Tourism Services and Hospitality Management
- Training on Food Processing for Sri Lanka
- Seminar on Cultural and Heritage Preservation and Ecotourism for Sustainable Development for Junior Diplomats of the Philippines and other Developing Countries

TCCP had preparatory meetings with the Department of Science and Technology - Industrial Technology Development Institute (DOST-ITDI), Department of Agriculture - Philippine Rice Research Institute (DA-PHILRICE), Department of Interior and Local Government - Philippine Commission on Women (DILG-PCW), and De la Salle University - College of Saint Benilde (DLSU-CSB) for the implementation of the said projects. It was not able to implement any of the above due to the following:


- The projects' original designs required experts or participants to undertake *international travel*;
- Both TCCP and its partner agencies necessitated upgrading of their capabilities to conduct non-face-to-face international trainings / seminars and blended type of learning;
- Training institutions adapted their mandated program to the new normal putting projects with TCCP on the secondary priority.

TCCP, in its FY 2021 Catch-Up Plan, intends to implement most of the projects scheduled for FY 2020.

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
