**RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING AWARD OF THE CONTRACT ON
PROCUREMENT OF REPLACEMENT AIRCONDITIONING SYSTEM AT DFA
OCA-ASEANA**

WHEREAS, the Department of Foreign Affairs, through the authorized appropriations under the 2021 General Appropriations Act (GAA), intends to apply the sum of Seventy-One Million Pesos (*PhP 71,000,000.00*) only, being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) for the *Procurement of Replacement Airconditioning System at DFA OCA-Aseana*;

WHEREAS, the said Approved Budget for the Contract is chargeable against the FY 2021 Building Fund for Office Equipment;

WHEREAS, on 23 September 2021, the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) Secretariat posted for seven (7) consecutive calendar days the *Invitation to Bid* for the *Procurement of Replacement Airconditioning System at DFA OCA-Aseana* on the DFA and PhilGEPS websites, and conspicuous places within the premises of the DFA, in accordance with Section 21.2 of the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) 9184;

WHEREAS, on 01 October 2021, the BAC held a *Pre-Bid Conference*, to discuss the eligibility requirements and the technical and financial components of the contract to be bid, in which five (5) prospective bidders attended namely: MCCD Engineering Services & Trading, Innovalite, Inc., ACMI Office Systems Philippines, Inc., FMG Refrigeration and Airconditioning Services., and True-Temp Corporation;

WHEREAS, Supplemental/Bid Bulletin No. 1 (01 October 2021), amending and clarifying information in the bidding documents, was posted on the PhilGEPS and DFA websites for at least seven (7) consecutive days before the deadline for submission and opening of bids, pursuant to Section 22.5.2 of the IRR of RA 9184;

WHEREAS, Supplemental/Bid Bulletin No. 2 (04 October 2021), amending and clarifying information in the bidding documents, was posted on the PhilGEPS and DFA websites for at least seven (7) consecutive days before the deadline for submission and opening of bids, pursuant to Section 22.5.2 of the IRR of RA 9184;

WHEREAS, Supplemental/Bid Bulletin No. 3 (12 October 2021), amending and clarifying information in the bidding documents, was posted on the PhilGEPS and DFA websites for least seven (7) consecutive days before the deadline for submission and opening of bids, pursuant to Section 22.5.2 of the IRR of RA 9184;

WHEREAS, on 20 October 2021, the deadline for the submission and receipt of bids as well as the date of opening thereof, two (2) bidders, namely, True-Temp Corporation and MCCD Engineering Services & Trading submitted their respective bids which the BAC determined to be as follows:

WHEREAS, the BAC declared ***MCCD Engineering Services & Trading*** as having the Lowest Calculated Bid, and subjected it to Post-Qualification on 25 October 2021, pursuant to Section 34.2 of the IRR of RA 9184, to determine whether it complies with and is responsive to all the requirements and conditions specified in the Bidding Documents;

WHEREAS, during the post-qualification of bids and after careful consideration, the BAC determined that the bid of ***MCCD Engineering Services & Trading*** was compliant with and is responsive to all the requirements and conditions specified in the Bidding Documents;

NOW, THEREFORE, we, the members of the Bids and Awards Committee, unanimously RESOLVE to RECOMMEND the award of the contract for the Procurement of Replacement Airconditioning System at DFA OCA-Aseana to ***MCCD Engineering Services & Trading*** for having submitted the Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bid in the amount of **Sixty-Two Million Six Hundred Thirty Thousand Five Pesos and Ten Centavos (PhP 62,630,005.10)** only, pursuant to Section 37 of the revised IRR of RA 9184.


