RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING AWARD OF THE CONTRACT ON THE OPERATION, MAINTENANCE, AND REPAIR SERVICES FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS' VENTILATION AND AIRCONDITIONING SYSTEM (JANUARY TO MARCH 2022)

WHEREAS, the Department of Foreign Affairs, through the authorized appropriations under the FY 2022 National Expenditure Program (NEP), intends to apply the sum of Four Million Pesos (*PhP 4,000,000.00*) only – the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) for the *Procurement of Operation, Maintenance, and Repair Services for the Department of Foreign Affairs' Ventilation and Airconditioning System (January to March 2022)*;

WHEREAS, the ABC is chargeable against OAMSS' FY 2022 MOOE – Repairs and Maintenance – Buildings;

WHEREAS, on 23 November 2021, the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) Secretariat posted for seven (7) consecutive calendar days the *Invitation to Bid* for the *Procurement of Operation, Maintenance, and Repair Services for the Department of Foreign Affairs' Ventilation and Airconditioning System (January to March 2022)* on the DFA and PhilGEPS websites, and at conspicuous places within the premises of the DFA, in accordance with Section 21.2 of the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) 9184;

WHEREAS, on 02 December 2021, the BAC held a *Pre-Bid Conference*, to discuss the eligibility requirements and the technical and financial components of the contract to be bid, in which four (4) prospective bidders attended namely: MCCD Engineering Services & Trading, Rose Air Enterprise, Inc., MPS Ref. and Aircon Repair Service, Impact One Nation Industrial Corporation;

WHEREAS, on 15 December 2021, the deadline for the submission and receipt of bids as well as the date of opening thereof, only MCCD Engineering Services & Trading submitted a bid which the BAC determined to be as follows:

WHEREAS, the BAC declared *MCCD Engineering Services & Trading* as having the Single Lowest Calculated Bid, and subjected it to Post-Qualification on 20 December 2021, pursuant to Section 34.2 of the IRR of RA 9184, to determine whether it complied with and was responsive to all the requirements and conditions specified in the Bidding Documents;

WHEREAS, during the post-qualification of bids and after careful consideration, the BAC determined that the bid of **MCCD Engineering Services & Trading** was compliant with and was responsive to all the requirements and conditions specified in the Bidding Documents;

NOW, THEREFORE, we, the members of the Bids and Awards Committee, unanimously RESOLVE to RECOMMEND the award of the Contract on the Operation, Maintenance, and Repair Services for the Department of Foreign Affairs' Ventilation and Airconditioning System (January to March 2022) to MCCD Engineering Services & Trading for having submitted the Single Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bid in the amount of Three Million Two Hundred Twenty-Nine Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (PhP 3,229,500.00) only, pursuant to Section 37 of the revised IRR of RA 9184.
