Unlimited corrective maintenance/repair activity. 3. Eight (8) hours by five (5) days support during contract duration 4. One (1) hour response time for technical phone support upon receipt of ticket request from DFA IT support team. 5. On site repair if not resolved through phone support. 6. If the hardware cannot be repaired on site due to extraordinary hardware difficulties and needs to be pulled-out, the replacement for the pulled-out hardware must be repaired, delivered, installed and tested within 10 calendar days 7. Pull out, repair, delivery, installation and testing of the appliance shall be free of charge, if on site repair cannot be done 8. The Contractor shall ensure that each of its personnel assigned to provide support service for the Warranty for Cybersecurity executes and signs a Non-Disclosure Agreement which is to be submitted to the Department prior to commencement of the service. 2. The Contractor shall not disclose any confidential information accessed through the use of its services in relation to the official functions or operations of the Department without prior consent from the latter. 3. The Contractor shall immediately inform the Department of breaches, attacks or other form of cyber threats/activities that may contribute to disclosure of any confidential information. 4. Failure to comply with the confidentiality clause shall be subject to penalties as provided in Republic Act No. 10173 – Data Privacy Act of 2012 and all other relevant rules and regulations. 	
VII	<p>Duration and Delivery</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The Contractor shall renew product warranty and maintain Department’s ICT equipment within thirty (30) days from the receipt of the Notice to Proceed (NTP). 	
VIII	<p>Payment</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The Contractor shall be paid within forty-five (45) working days upon the submission of the sales invoice, or its equivalent complete with supporting documents examined by the Office of Financial Management Services-Financial Resource Management Division (OFMS-FRMD). Payments shall be 	

	made through List of Due and Demandable Accounts Payable (LDDAP).	
	All payments shall be inclusive of all applicable taxes and other lawful charges.	

Note:

Bidder must state compliance to each of the provisions in the Terms of Reference/Technical Specifications, as well as to the Schedule to Requirements. The **STATEMENT OF COMPLIANCE** must be signed by the authorized representative of the Bidder, with proof of authority to sign and submit the bid for and on behalf of the Bidder concerned. If the Bidder is a joint venture, the representative must have authority to sign for and on behalf of the partners to the joint venture. All documentary requirements should be submitted on or before the deadline for the submission of bids.

Bidders must state here either “Comply” or “Not Comply” against each of the individual parameters of each Specification stating the corresponding performance parameter of the equipment offered. Statements of “Comply” or “Not Comply” must be supported by evidence in a Bidders Bid and cross-referenced to that evidence. Evidence shall be in the form of a manufacturer’s un-amended sales literature, unconditional statements of specification and compliance issued by the manufacturer, samples, independent test data etc., as appropriate. A statement that is not supported by evidence is subsequently found to be contradicted by the evidence presented will render the Bid under evaluation liable for rejection. A statement either in the Bidders statement of compliance or the supporting evidence that is found to be false either during Bid evaluation, post-qualification or the execution of the Contract may be regarded as fraudulent and render the Bidder or supplier liable for prosecution subject to the provisions of **ITB** Clause 3.1 (a)(ii) and/or **GCC** Clause 2.1 (a)(ii)
