RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING, BY REFERENDUM, AWARD OF CONTRACT THROUGH NEGOTIATED PROCUREMENT UNDER SECTION 53.6 (SCIENTIFIC, SCHOLARLY OR ARTISTIC WORK, EXCLUSIVE TECHNOLOGY AND MEDIA SERVICES) AS ALTERNATIVE METHOD OF PROCUREMENT FOR THE HIRING OF A FIRM TO PROVIDE THE SUBSCRIPTION, OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF THE DFA LEARNING MANAGEMENT SYSTEM AND CONVERSION TO THE DIGITAL FORMAT OF COURSES

WHEREAS, the Human Resources Management Office (HRMO) intends to hire a firm to provide the subscription, operation and maintenance of the Department's learning management system (LMS) and conversion to the digital format of courses, as an online learning platform to all DFA personnel;

WHEREAS, the procurement for the hiring of a firm to provide the subscription, operation and maintenance of the learning management system of DFA and conversion to the digital format of courses, by the HRMO, with an Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) in the amount of *Three Million Eighty-Six Thousand Pesos* (PhP 3,086,000.00) only, is included in the Department's Annual Procurement Plan (APP) for CY 2022;

WHEREAS, Section 53 of the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of R.A. 9184, otherwise known as the Government Procurement Reform Act of 2003, allows an agency to resort to Negotiated Procurement;

WHEREAS, further, Section 53.6 of the said Revised IRR can be resorted where Goods, Infrastructure Projects and Consulting Services can be contracted from a particular supplier, contractor or consultant as determined by the Head of the Procuring Entity (HOPE), for any of the following requirements: (b) Scientific, academic, scholarly work or research, or legal services, *inter alia*;

WHEREAS, the HRMO submitted to the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) a quotation from the *Buri Technologies Inc.* to provide the subscription, operation and maintenance of the DFA learning management system and conversion to the digital format of courses, in the total amount of *Three Million Eighty-Six Thousand Pesos* (PhP 3,086,000.00) *only;*

WHEREAS, the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC), after taking into consideration all relevant factors, finds that the awarding of the procurement for hiring of a firm to provide the subscription, operation and maintenance of the learning management system (LMS) and conversion to the digital format of courses, may be done under Section 53.6 (b) of the 2016 revised IRR of R.A. 9184;

NOW, **THEREFORE**, we, the members of the Bids and Awards Committee of the Department, RESOLVE to RECOMMEND to the Head of the Procuring Entity (HOPE) the resort to Negotiated Procurement under Section 53.6 as the alternative
