RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING, BY REFERENDUM, AWARD OF CONTRACT THROUGH NEGOTIATED PROCUREMENT UNDER SECTION 53.10 (LEASE OF REAL PROPERTY/VENUE) THE LEASE OF VENUE FOR THE GAD TRAINING AND WELLNESS ACTIVITY ON 02-03 SEPTEMBER 2022 OF THE OVERSEAS VOTING SECRETARIAT (OVS)

WHEREAS, the Overseas Voting Secretariat (OVS) intends to lease a venue for the GAD Training and Wellness Activity on 02-03 September 2022;

WHEREAS, the lease of venue for said event by the OVS, with an Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) in the amount of *One Hundred Forty-Four Thousand Pesos (PhP 144,000.00)* only, is included in the Department's Annual Procurement Plan (APP) for CY 2022;

WHEREAS, Sec. 53.10 of the 2016 revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) No. 9184, otherwise known as the "Government Procurement Reform Act of 2003", allows Negotiated Procurement as a mode of procurement for the lease of privately owned real property and venue for official use, subject to the Consolidated Guidelines for the Alternative Methods of Procurement of the 2016 Revised IRR of RA 9184;

WHEREAS, Annex H(IV)(J) of the 2016 revised IRR allows the conduct of Shopping and Negotiated Procurement under Emergency Cases, Small Value Procurement and Lease of Real Property and Venue to be delegated to the End-user unit or any other appropriate bureau, committee, or support unit duly authorized by the BAC;

WHEREAS, Part IV, Item A, Annex "H" of the IRR allows the Procuring Entity to change the mode of procurement, if the original mode in the Annual Procurement Plan can no longer be pursued;

WHEREAS, in compliance with Item No. (V)(C)(2)(b)(iv), Annex H of the IRR, separate Requests for Quotation (RFQ) were also sent to at least three (3) potential suppliers;

WHEREAS, the following quotations were received from: Escala Tagaytay (failed; no available rooms on 02-03 September 2022), Taal Vista Hotel (PhP 193,512.00; failed; insufficient, exceeded the ABC), and Summit Hotel and Resorts (Robinsons Land Corporation), which submitted the lowest calculated and responsive quotation in the amount of One Hundred Forty-Four Thousand Pesos (Php 144,000.00) only;

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NOW, THEREFORE, we, the members of the Bids and Awards Committee of the Department, RESOLVE to RECOMMEND to the Head of Procuring Entity (HOPE) to resort to Negotiated Procurement (Lease of Real Property/Venue) as the alternative method of procurement for the lease of venue for said event from the **Summit Hotel and Resorts (Robinsons Land Corporation)** subject to the above- mentioned requirements and provided that existing auditing rules and regulations shall be strictly observed by the end-user.
