# AGREEMENT FOR THE PROCUREMENT OF DIPLOMATIC POUCH SERVICES FOR THE PERIOD OF NOVEMBER 2022 TO DECEMBER 2022

## KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

**DEPARTMENT OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS,** (hereafter, the PROCURING ENTITY), with principal office address at 2330 Roxas Blvd., Pasay City, 1300 Metro Manila, represented by its Undersecretary and Head of the Procuring Entity (HOPE) HONORABLE **ANTONIO A. MORALES**,

BLUE CHIP MARKETING, (hereinafter, the CONTRACTOR), a company duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the Philippines, as evidenced by the submitted Department of Trade and Industry (DTI) Certificate of Registration No. 1550813 dated 05 February 2020 (ANNEX "A") with principal address at 1441 Dagupan St., Tondo, Manila, represented by its owner, WILLIAM N. BATAC, who is duly authorized to enter into this Agreement being the Single Proprietor pursuant to the Eligibility Document copy of which is attached as ANNEX "B" and made an integral part as this AGREEMENT.

#### WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the PROCURING ENTITY invited bids for the Procurement of Diplomatic Pouch Services and has accepted a bid by the CONTRACTOR to provide service in the amount of Seven Million Eight Hundred Eighty-Four Thousand Four Hundred Thirty Nine Pesos 20/100 (PhP7,884,439.20) only, (hereinafter, the Contract Price), inclusive of all applicable taxes and other lawful charges.

WHEREAS, the parties complied with the relevant requirements of Republic Act No. 9184 otherwise known as the "Government Procurement Reform Act" and Government Procurement Policy Board (GPPB) Rules and Regulations, and entered in to this AGREEMENT, pursuant to BAC Resolution No. CPM-PB-28-2022 dated 14November 2022.

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, the PARTIES agree as follows:

- The definitions included in the General and Special Conditions of the Contract provided in the Philippine Bidding Documents for Procurement of Goods and Services issued by the Government Procurement Policy Board (GPPB) are deemed incorporated in this AGREEMENT.
  - "In case of conflict or inconsistencies between or among any of the documents referred to herein and/or annexed to this Agreement, the provisions contained in this main Agreement and Technical Specifications shall be controlling."



# RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING AWARD OF THE CONTRACT ON THE PROCUREMENT OF DIPLOMATIC POUCH SERVICES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS (NOVEMBER TO DECEMBER 2022)

WHEREAS, the Department of Foreign Affairs, through the authorized appropriations under the 2022 General Appropriations Act (GAA), intends to apply the sum of Eight Million Pesos (PhP 8,000,000.00) only being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) for the Procurement of Diplomatic Pouch Services of the Department of Foreign Affairs (November to December 2022);

WHEREAS, the Approved Budget Contract (ABC) is chargeable against OAMSS's FY 2022 MOOE for Postage and Courier Services and is included in the Department's 2022 Annual Procurement Plan:

WHEREAS, on 14 October 2022, the Bids and Awards Committee and representatives of the end-user unit conducted a pre-procurement meeting as required by Section 20 of the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) 9184;

WHEREAS, on 20 October 2022, the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) Secretariat posted for seven (7) consecutive calendar days the *Invitation to Bid* for the Procurement of Diplomatic Pouch Services of the Department of Foreign Affairs on the DFA and PhilGEPS websites, and conspicuous places within the premises of the DFA, in accordance with Section 21.2 of RA 9184's IRR;

WHEREAS, on 27 October 2022, the BAC held a *Pre-Bid Conference* to discuss the eligibility requirements and the technical and financial components of the contract to be bid, which was attended by Blue Chip Marketing;

WHEREAS, Supplemental Bid Bulletin No. 1 (dated 27 October 2022), amending and clarifying information in the bidding documents was posted on the PhilGEPS and DFA websites, and conspicuous places within the premises of the DFA, for at least seven (7) consecutive days before the deadline for submission and opening of bids, pursuant to Section 22.5.2 of the IRR of RA 9184:

WHEREAS, on 09 November 2022, the deadline for the submission and receipt of bids as well as the date of opening thereof, only Blue Chip Marketing submitted a bid, which the BAC determined to be as follows:
