BAC Resolution No. HO 240-23

RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING, BY REFERENDUM, AWARD OF CONTRACT THROUGH NEGOTIATED PROCUREMENT UNDER SECTION 53.2 (EMERGENCY CASES) FOR THE EMERGENCY PROCUREMENT FOR THE DFA MAIN BUILDING LIFT STATION PUMPS' REPAIR AND REHABILITATION

WHEREAS, there is an immediate need for the Department of Foreign Affairs ("DFA"), through the Office of Asset Management and Support Services ("OAMSS"), to procure sump pumps and services for the repair and rehabilitation of the DFA Main Building lift station pumps;

WHEREAS, the emergency procurement for the DFA Main Building Lift Station Pumps' repair and rehabilitation with an Approved Budget for the Contract ("ABC") of *Two Million Pesos* (PhP 2,000,000.00) only, chargeable against the Department's FY 2022 Continuing Appropriations under Repairs and Maintenance - Buildings, is included in the Department's Supplemental Annual Procurement Plan ("SAPP") for FY 2023;

WHEREAS, Section 53 of the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations ("IRR") of Republic Act ("RA") No. 9184, otherwise known as the "Government Procurement Reform Act of 2003", allows an agency to resort to Negotiated Procurement;

WHEREAS, further, Section 53.2 (Emergency Cases) of the said IRR provides that Negotiated Procurement can be resorted to "[i]n case of imminent danger to life or property during a state of calamity, or when time is of the essence arising from natural or man-made calamities or other causes where immediate action is necessary to prevent damage to or loss of life or property, or to restore vital public services, infrastructure facilities and other public utilities";

WHEREAS, due to overheating, the lift station pumps and repaired sump pumps of the Department broke down which resulted to flooding and septage problems, and the same should be addressed before the septage overflows and cause health hazards to personnel and the neighboring residential areas;

WHEREAS, OAMSS recommends the immediate replacement and rewinding of the pumps as the only cost-effective measure to address the flooding and septage problem in the Department given the urgent need to restore safe and normal building operations especially with the onslaught of the rainy season;

WHEREAS, the OAMSS submitted to Bids and Awards Committee a quotation from ***MCCD Engineering Services and Trading*** for the emergency procurement for the DFA Main Building Lift Station Pumps' repair and rehabilitation in the amount of *Two Million Pesos* (PhP 2,000,000.00) only;

NOW, THEREFORE, we, the Members of the Bids and Awards Committee of the Department, RESOLVE to RECOMMEND to the Head of the Procuring Entity the resort to Negotiated Procurement under Section 53.2 (Emergency Cases) as the alternative method of procurement for the emergency procurement for the DFA Main Building Lift Station Pumps' repair and rehabilitation from **MCCD Engineering Services and Trading**, subject to the abovementioned requirements, and provided that existing auditing rules and regulations shall be strictly observed by the end-user.




