Children's Book: "The Manila-Acapulco Galleon Trade"

As part of the Department's initiatives to strengthen bilateral relations between the Philippines and Mexico, the Department of Foreign Affairs - Office of American Affairs (DFA-OAA) intends to publish a children's book on the Manila-Acapulco Galleon Trade. The objectives of the project are as follows:

- 1. To develop awareness and teach Mexican primary students and Filipino primary students on the shared history between the Philippines and Mexico, focusing on the Manila-Acapulco Galleon Trade;
- 2. To highlight the contributions of the Philippines (people, products, culture) to present-day society of Mexico, and vice versa.
- 3. To instill among Mexican and Filipino children the significance of this era in shaping the shared culture and history of the Philippines and Mexico.

In this regard, the DFA-OAA wishes to procure the services of a publishing company for the publication of a colored picture book for children 8 to 10 years of age depicting the connection between the Philippines and Mexico highlighting the role of the Manila-Acapulco Galleon Trade.

REQUIREMENTS:

- Conceptualize, discuss, and draft the book's concept, design, and narrative including creation of original characters, content direction, and illustrations in consultation with and the approval of DFA representatives;
- 2. Conceptualize, write, and edit the story which includes the submission of the outline and main storyboard. The draft will undergo two (2) rounds of comments and revisions:
- 3. Ensure that the story is designed for at least a 28-page (excluding cover pages) storybook with colored illustrations and Filipino and Spanish texts.
- 4. Ensure historical accuracy of content and illustrations, in consultation with academicians, translators, and external sources
- 5. Shall ensure that the writer has the relevant degree (e.g. History, Latin American Studies, Education) and extensive knowledge on the subject, must have written/published research/journal articles and attended trainings relevant to the topic of the book
- 6. Shall ensure that the writer must have written/authored a published children's book
- 7. Design the layout of the book in consultation with DFA-OAA
- 8. The size of the book should be at least 7 x 9 inches.
- 9. The inside pages of the book must be at least 100gsm and the cover pages should be at least a fold coat 12
- 10. Deliver 3,000 books to complete the project. At least 1,000 books shall be delivered by the second week of December for the ceremonial book launch.
