This **Supplemental/Bid Bulletin** is issued to inform prospective bidders of the following clarifications to the Scope of Works of the Project:

1. Item VII.3 of Contractor's Qualifications

The absence of bad faith of the contractor shall be verified through the **GPPB Online Blacklisting Portal**, ensuring that the bidder's company/firm is not among the blacklisted entities.

2. "Class B" documents in the Checklist of Requirements

Bidders in joint ventures shall be guided by Section 23.1(b) of the IRR of RA 9184, which states:

"For Infrastructure Projects, JV bidders shall submit a JVA in accordance with R.A. 4566 and its IRR.

Each partner of the joint venture shall submit their respective PhilGEPS Certificates of Registration in accordance with Section 8.5.2 of this IRR. The submission of technical and financial eligibility documents by any of the joint venture partners constitutes compliance: Provided, That the partner responsible to submit the NFCC shall likewise submit the Statement of all of its ongoing contracts and Audited Financial Statements" (Emphasis and underscoring supplied).

3. Requirement of a "valid PCAB license"

Under the IRR and Invitation To Bid (ITB), a **Special PCAB License** is required for Joint Ventures (JVs), in accordance with Section 38 of RA 4566, as part of its technical eligibility documents.¹

Thus, for JV bidders to be engaged as a contractor, a special PCAB license for JVs issued pursuant to Section 38 of RA 4566 and Section 3.5 of its associated IRR must be submitted as part of the technical eligibility documents. The submission of PCAB license and registration individually issued to each JV partner will not suffice.
